Education and Background Details	Mr. Md. Raisul Islam was born in Kushtia District under Khulna Division. He completed both his secondary and higher secondary education in Kushtia. Then he completed his graduation in Environmental Science and Resource Management from Mawlana Bhashani Science and Technology University and post-graduation in Environmental Science from Bangladesh Agricultural University. He conducted a thesis during his graduation on leather effluent's effect on River water quality. He also performed a thesis work during his post-graduation on CH ₄ emission from paddy field.
Professional Experiences	After completion his post-graduation he worked in industrial consultancy firm as an Executive-Social and Environmental Inspection.
